OCT Device (Optical Coherence Tomography)

Using laser light to produce a highly detailed cross-section of the various tissues inside the eye, the OCT device is much more effective in detecting and managing glaucoma, macular degeneration, retinal damage, and complications from diabetes than traditional methods.



iProfiler

The iProfiler enables your optometrist to measure your prescription to 1/100th of a dioptre, providing the most precise, balanced prescription and offering crisper, brighter vision, especially at night.



MSI Device (Multi-Spectral Imaging)

The MSI device uses various spectrums of light to view the individual layers of the retina to provide earlier detection of potentially threatening conditions such as macular degeneration, glaucoma, diabetes, and hypertension.



A Closer Look at Eyelid Twitching

Do you ever experience eyelid twitching? Almost everyone has experienced these involuntary twitches of the eyelid at one time or another. The medical term for this is *Eyelid Myokymia*. In most cases, it's just an annoyance that is harmless.

What Causes Eyelid Twitching?

Certain situations and various behaviours can exacerbate these irritating eyelid tremors:

Stress - Eyelid twitching can be a manifestation of stress. The best solution is to deal with the source of stress, eat healthy food, and get regular exercise.

Fatigue - Along with low energy and lots of yawning, fatigue can also result in eyelid twitching. Try to rest your eyes and get more sleep.

Dry eyes - Aging, taking certain medications, or wearing contact lenses can cause dry eyes and also result in eyelid twitching. Your optometrist can help you find a solution, such as eye moisturizing drops or contact lenses designed specifically for people with dry eyes.

Tired eyes - If you have experienced a deterioration of your eyesight or if you're spending too much time in front of your computer, your eyes can get tired and start twitching. Having an eye exam or wearing eyeglasses for computers could remedy the problem.



Tobacco, alcohol, and caffeine -Consuming any of these stimulants or depressants can cause eyelid twitching. Decreasing your consumption of these products will reduce your symptoms.

Eyelid twitching generally disappears within a few hours or a few days. If it lasts longer than two or three weeks and is continuous, or spreads to the face, it is best to consult your optometrist. Although it is generally harmless, in rare cases the twitch may be the sign of a more serious problem.

The next time you are the victim of that little oddity of eyelid twitching, de-stress and get some rest; your eyelids should once again keep still. And if you have any doubts or further concerns, schedule an eye health exam.

Ordering Eyeglasses Online: Convenient or a Reason for Concern?

Shopping for eyeglasses online certainly offers convenience from the comfort of your home. Armed with a prescription from your optometrist, ordering online can be quick and inexpensive. But be wary: ordering a pair of glasses online is not as easy as buying clothing. Every pair of eyeglasses must be custom-fitted to your face and your particular prescriptive needs. It's important to work together with your optician to ensure a proper fit.

A recent study conducted by the American Optometric Association discovered that nearly half of all glasses ordered online either contained an inaccurate prescription or didn't meet safety standards designed to protect the eyes.

Out of 200 pairs of glasses ordered from the most popular online vendors, only 154 pairs were received. Several pairs were delivered incorrectly, such as single vision instead of bifocals, or lens treatments that were added or omitted. Nearly three out of ten pairs had at least one lens that failed to meet the required prescription, and 23 percent of the lenses failed impact resistance testing, which highlights a major safety issue. Children's glasses performed even worse, with 29 percent failing impact testing.

Take the best care of your eye health by purchasing your eyeglasses from a licensed optometrist. They will help ensure that your eyeglasses are the right lens material and prescription, have the proper protective coatings, and fit your face comfortably. They can also ensure they are an attractive style that complements your face shape and colouring so you can see and look your best.
