
Managing GLAUCOMA

According to the National Coalition for Vision Health 300,000 Canadians are affected by Glaucoma. Of that number 50% are unaware they have the disease.

Glaucoma is actually a group of eye diseases that

cause damage to the optic nerve. If left untreated it can cause permanent vision loss and lead to total blindness. It is often referred to as a "silent thief" of vision, gradually stealing sight without warning and often without symptoms.



The exact cause of glaucoma is unknown. It is often linked to the internal (intraocular) pressure in the eye. The pressure in the eye is maintained by the flow and production of a thick watery substance that fills the space between the cornea (front surface of the eye) and the lens. In some people glaucoma develops when there is an overproduction of fluid. In other cases, the passages that allow the fluid to flow within in the eye become clogged or blocked. In either scenario, when the fluid has no where to go, the increase in pressure damages the nerve fibers and blood vessels in the optic nerve, the weakest area of the eye.

developing glaucoma, but it can occur at any age. A strong family history of glaucoma can also increase your risk of developing the disease. Other risk factors include diabetes, high blood pressure and eve injuries. Glaucoma is a complex disease to diagnose.

Regular comprehensive eye health examinations are the key to early detection.

Your optometrist is on the front line of glaucoma detection and will often work in partnership with an ophthalmologist specializing in glaucoma to manage and treat those affected by the disease

Your optometrist's diagnostic methods used include a visual field screening, measurement of the intraocular pressure, internal examination of the optic nerve, photo documentation of the nerve and pachymetry (measurement of the corneal thickness). Testing of the retinal nerve fibre layer on an OCT (Ocular Coherence Tomography) instrument, and a comprehensive field test to measure nerve function on a Humphrey's Field Analyzer are also used to diagnose the disease.

Treatment for glaucoma involves medicated eye drops and/or surgery to achieve a desired target pressure within the eye. Diligent follow up appointments either with your optometrist or ophthalmologist, and compliance with your treatment regimen will slow the progression of the disease and help preserve your vision. Someone with Moderate-stage	Every 6 months
Someone with Advanced Glaucoma	Every 4 months

Our safety package includes industrial standard lenses, frames, and side shields at very affordable prices. Our basic package including single vision lenses is priced at \$126 with progressive lens packages starting at \$229. These packages are also available at a non-group rate for individuals.



- Do not rub your eye
- If your natural tears do not flush the particle out, flush your eye with cool water.(Be sure to wash your hands before touching your eye.)
- Remove the particle with a wet cotton swab while holding your upper or lower lid open.
- Never try to remove anything that is embedded or lodged in your eye. Cover your eye with a loose dressing, being careful to avoid putting pressure on the eye, and proceed to your optometrist or emergency room.
- NOTE: Chemical burns are always considered an emergency:
 - Rinse the eyes immediately with gently flowing water for at least 20 minutes (Rinse right over contact lenses, do not remove them.)
 - After a few minutes, begin to rinse the unaffected eye, because the rinsing process could wash some of the chemical into the unaffected eye.



Vision can be threatened by foreign bodies, trauma, infection, or exposure to chemicals or particulate matter, such as dense smoke. Guard your sight.

Protect your eyes with safety glasses.

A common procedure in our office is "foreign body" removal. Debris in your eyes can result when you're doing yard work, home repairs or common handyman projects.

We carry non-prescription safety kits that contain 3 shields: one clear, one tinted and one sunshield. The protective shields are high impact resistant, and feature anti-fog, anti-static and anti-scratch treatments. The sun shields offer 100% UV protection. They are available for \$49 including a case, cleaner and lanyard.
